6. Superintendents Quarterly Report (DANE)

Financial report was handed out and read.

7. New Business (DANE)

- Vietnam veterans should be on watch mail regarding past denied claims. The VA has found new diseases can be refiled.
- The VAC will be in the Veterans Day Parade.
- 21 Tiny homes for veterans are being built on Stanton Ave for veterans.
- Jan - Dec van trips to VA facilities were handed out. We are down to only two volunteer drivers: Dale and Marvin. Decatur and Peoria twice a month. Trips to Danville run 4 times a month. Volunteer drivers need a physical, a regular driver's license and a VA Identification card. Patient riders have to get in/out of the van on their own power.
- VAC has positions for 3 work study students to help in the office. Must be a veteran using Gi bill benefits or a dependent on GI bill benefits of a disabled sponsor. A work study can do school work while assisting VAC staff with phone calls, walkins, etc. Minimum wage is paid but there is no social security or taxes deducted. Students can set their own hours.
- "Community Care" program is available for local medical needs.
