III. Approval of minutes

Before we got started with the meeting, Frank Tyree explained that the by-laws were not followed in the past regarding the timing of the election that was held in October instead of January per the by-laws. The last two years were a bit off schedule during COVID. Before we do anything else, a new vote was made to rectify the mistake for an interim board until the next legitimate time in the coming January. Members voted to retain the same board under these circumstances.

The previous quarter's minutes were distributed to voting members. After a review by those present, corrections were noted. A Motion was made to dispense with reading of the January minutes with corrections discussed. Once approved and corrections made, the minutes will be posted online.

The Superintendents Quarterly Report was read by VAC Superintendent, Dane Shaffer. Hard copies were distributed to those present and publicly posted. January through March looked very good.

Shawn Miller asked for a better tracker broken down by VSO from the number of claims, number of appeals, by VSO and if they are continuous appeals. In other words how much work is being done. Shawn wants to know the numbers that go with the one million dollars represented. Dane said data is broken down on their VetPro system. (https://myvac.org/about-the-vac/transparency/).

The previous discussion on the status of VAC staff pay raises was discussed by VAC Superintendent, Dane Shaffer. This project is still in progress and will be continued to the Q1 2023 Quarterly Meeting.

- A motion was made to record/video the current meeting and post that online. Motion was seconded. Upon discussion, Jay read an email from Dane regarding misinformation at the

last meeting. Frank Tyree said he was unaware of the witness statements and had subsequently spoken with Dane to resolve the issue so it won't happen again. Equipment for recording was brought up. Meetings are currently recorded for typing up the minutes but the recordings are hard to hear. Shawn Miller mentioned blind courtesy copy (BCC) of that email also being made transparent. Rose had mentioned that the minutes are considered a draft until voted upon at the next quarterly meeting and therefore current meetings must be approved before being posted online. A vote 4 for the motion and 5 nay against recording at this time.

- Dane revisited the practicality of making trips to Danville. Illinois Assistive Technology
 moved into a building that would have been an ideal location for a CBOC but VA planning is
 on a 10 year planning cycle. Our guest representatives of congressman Budinski at this
 meeting stated she is in favor of a CBOC in Springfield.

VI. Old business

A new sub-committee with *6 members* was formed to review the by-laws. Members on the committee include Jay Hoffman, Shawn Miller, Mike Woodcox, Dan Davis, Tim Kennedy, and Bill Maud. The chair for the by-laws committee is Shawn Miller. The committee will set their own meeting date and report to Frank Tyree their recommendations.

Dental assistance will be on website NLT May 1. Community Care has dental.

Financial assistance guidelines have been changed and veterans can apply online or paper applications.

There's an annual all at once policy for food, rent, and utilities to save time and paperwork.

County resolution 22-2 passed on Oct 19, 2022 appointing new titles of Jeff and Duane effective immediately. In the past, a new hire would be an administrative assistant. Our new hire, Bridget Crawford, will have the title of Associate Veterans Service officer.
