## III. Approval of minutes

Members voted to dispense with reading of the last quarter minutes because hard copies were passed out. Minutes approved.

The Superintendents Quarterly Report was read by VAC Superintendent, Dane Shaffer. Hard copies were distributed to those present and publicly posted. The quarterly report for the 2d quarter 2022 was compared with the 2d quarter of 2023. The numbers were down.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

Shawn Miller introduced the committee that reviewed the by laws dated in 2012. Copies of the by laws were handed out. Open meetings act was included in the proposed changes because our funds come from the public. Add a fourth position to the board provost marshall. Appeals board for financial aid. A little more oversight.

Frank Tyree said that we should take the by-laws home and look over carefully for a vote at the next meeting.

Frank said we need an outreach committee to get back for a quorum to vote. Some posts have not been at the meetings in a long time.

#### IV. Unfinished business

The previous discussion on the status of VAC staff pay raises was discussed by VAC Superintendent, Dane Shaffer. The April 2022 raises that have been voted are not received by the staff. there is a shortfall of .02%.

Tim Moore (from the VSO training) recommended we go through Josh Herman, an attorney out of Peoria reach out on behalf of the body of this VAC commission. He can get it solved with an email or phone call. Motion was made that as a committee we go forth representing the veterans of Sangamon County with backing if necessary the county doesn't want to give up that 2%. backed by a letter from the committee chair post and commanders to fight for VAC. The Commission is coming together with all the veterans that we represent to the county or we will get a lawyer. Motion passed.

## V. New business

The location of the VAC is moving soon. Township wants their building back. A location on Old Jacksonville rd and Rt 4 on NW corner known as the Freedom Building. Suggested location has room to expand parking a little further away from town. Ernie Moody, owner, is a veteran. Price \$3,000 a month includes utilities. He wants the office to buy the existing furniture. The current VAC has county hand-me-down furniture that needs to be upgraded. Biran McFadden needs to approve the plan to move. Comparatively, the Peoria office rent is \$3,500 month. Dane said he will send video tours of the building to those that leave a cell phone number to text the videos.

Frank Tyree announced that Dane is resigning as superintendent to concentrate on Veterans Service Officer assistance. He has 90 days to submit this resignation but will wait to abide by the new by-laws get approved at our next quarterly meeting.
